



Prof. Elżbieta Frąckowiak

Elżbieta Frąckowiak is a Professor at Poznań University of Technology in Poland. Elżbieta graduated in 1972 from the Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań. In 1991 she received a DAAD scholarship for a stay in Duisburg, Germany. Between 1993 and 2001 she participated in internships at CNRS-Université d'Orléans in France in the positions of research director and visiting professor. Elżbieta now works in the Institute of Chemistry and Technical Electrochemistry at the Faculty of Chemical Technology, Poznan University of Technology. Her research field is energy storage and conversion with special emphasis on electrochemical capacitors, lithium-ion batteries, fuel cells and hydrogen electrosorption in carbon materials. She is particularly interested in electrode materials from activated carbons, carbon nanotubes, carbons enriched with heteroatoms (nitrogen, oxygen), graphene materials, conducting polymers and composites.
