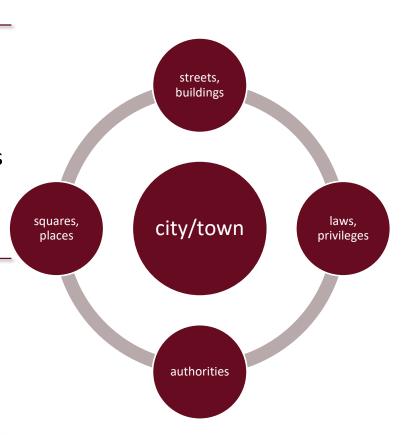


Idea and a core notion

Goal: to build an IT system, including database and ontology, suitable for European towns in the past allowing different teams dealing with **historic town atlases** to work in a uniform pattern, to enable future exchange of data sets and to improve data harmonization and comparative research.

Time and space: We are working on changes occurring in urban space from the 16th c. to the beginning of the 20th c. along with permanent elements that we think can constitute the town.

Sources: We use various historical sources, including tax registers, municipal books, maps and city plans.
