Holder of a Deug in Geography, a DUT in Social Careers and a DESS in Strategy and Engineering of Adult Education, he works in the associative sector (notably Director of STAJ Touraine) before getting involved in local public action. He now has a "Transitions" company that supports local authorities, companies and associations in the conduct of their transitions.

In 2001, he led the municipal list of alternative Tourangelle, ecologist and citizen. In 2009, he was a candidate for civil society on the Europe Ecology Les Verts list for regional authorities. Elected, he served as Vice-Chair of the environmental group in the regional assembly from 2010 to 2015. In 2015, he led the Ecologist and Citizen List for the regional elections and is currently Vice-President of the Regional Council in charge of Ecological and Citizen Transition and Cooperation. He is also president of the Ecologist group, bringing together the nine elected representatives from the list he led.
